As president of the ULC, which provides states with nonpartisan legislation that clarifies critical areas of state statutory law, Lisa is responsible for setting the organization's priorities, implementing the policies adopted by the ULC and determining the agenda of acts to be considered and drafted, as well as serving as liaison with other national and international legal associations. She is also a member of ULC drafting committees for the Amendments to the Harmonized Business Organizations Acts (chair), Limited Liability Company Protected Series Act, the Employee and Student Online Privacy Protection Act, and the Registration of Canadian Money Judgments Act.

Prior to joining Stradley Ronon, Lisa was a partner at an international law firm, where she focused her practice on corporate finance issues with an emphasis on hospitality and the healthcare industries.
